## **Prayer in Events Week:**

**College prayer meetings** will be organised by reps/college guests on Tuesday and Thursday in the week.

Upstairs in Stag there will be a **prayer room** which will be open for people to pray in during events and while the café is open. We'll try and ensure there's always someone praying during every event!

## **Week 1**

16/01	pray that God would uphold and sustain the events week committee through the busyness of this term
17/01	pray for Vaughan, that he would proclaim the gospel faithfully, and that he would seek God's wisdom in his preparation for the evening talks
18/01	pray for Kristi, that she would grow in her love and knowledge of God, and that she too would communicate the gospel clearly and faithfully
19/01	pray that the college guests would have good communication with college reps and that they would seize every opportunity to serve CU and all Cambridge students
20/01	pray for the Interviewees in the evening events, that they would be drawing near to God, and that what they say would be helpful to attendees
21/01	pray that college groups would remain united around the Gospel and support one another in prayer and friendship.

23/01	pray for the Science and Faith Event on 27/01 with Tom Mcleish, that he would speak faithfully, wisely and clearly, and that God would use this event to draw people to Him
24/01	pray for the social media publicity, that it would be used to communicate clearly what LIFE is, and that the news of Events week would reach those who otherwise might not hear about it
25/01	pray for the Launch Day on 3/02, that the Initial Encounters around the city would reach many people and that God would be softening hearts to bring people to Events
26/01	pray for 3
27/01	pray for 'Search' after Events Week, that many would be brought along to explore God's Word
28/01	pray for the venue and décor team, that Stag would be transformed into a welcoming venue where everyone feels welcome and comfortable
29/01	pray for the Acoustic Night tomorrow, that this event would bring glory to God, and that He would use it to transform lives and change hearts

30/01	pray for your college, that God would work powerfully in college members, and for any events you might be doing pre-events week
31/01	pray for God to soften the hearts of people in Cambridge to hear and respond to the Good News of the Gospel

2/02	pray for peace and energy for CU members, committee, speakers and interviewees as we look to the week ahead
3/02	pray that information about LIFE would be spread far and wide throughout Cambridge and God would use the events this week to bring revival in the city
4/02	pray that the events this week would bring glory to God's name and would be a witness to the joy and fullness of life we have in Him
5/02	pray that, as tiredness begins to kick in, the speakers would continue to seek God's face and be communicating the message of the Gospel clearly

## **Week 4**

6/02	pray for people to come to know the love and grace of God this week
7/02	pray for 3
8/02	praise God for the week and pray for any discouragements you may have had
9/02	pray for rest and refreshment for speakers, committee and CU members off the back of the last week
10/02	pray for the start of 'Search' this evening, that God would bring people to it, that conversations would be focused around His Word, and that people would want to come again and know more
11/02	pray for continued conversations off the back of last week, and the events before it, that we wouldn't doubt God is still working in us and our friends
12/02	pray for your college that many would recognise their sin, repent and turn to God for forgiveness

13/02	pray for 3
14/02	pray for the speakers and committee after events week, that they would be encouraged and thankful for God's provision through it all
15/02	pray for members of College Group in this busy part of term, that each person would be drawing near to God, to know the peace that comes from Him
16/02	pray thanks for the college guests, for their support in college and to the wider CICCU
17/02	pray for 'Search' this evening, that people who came last week would come again, and that God would use the interviews and studies to change hearts
18/02	praise for the table leaders at 'Search', and all the other student workers at churches in Cambridge, for the work they do for us all and their continued support of CU.
19/02	pray for the CICCU outreach event later in term, that the Gospel would be proclaimed clearly, and that lots of people would come and hear.

20/02	pray that we would never tire of hearing God's word preached, and we would never tire of telling it to others
21/02	pray for 3
22/02	pray for wisdom and energy for UCCF workers Mike Hood, Jack Payne and JP Sivertsen-Wright as they continue to support CICCU after Events Week
23/02	pray for 'Search' this evening that as we continue to look at Mark's gospel, those there would see and know Jesus more clearly and that God would be stirring people to commit their lives to him
